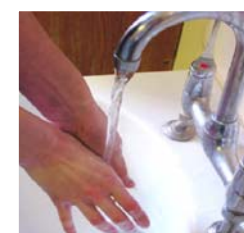


**Figure 2 - Aseptic non-touch techniques for accessing central lines (infusion device)**

1. Prepare tray (clean with Clinell wipe and allow to dry for 30 seconds)
2. Prepare equipment (check expiry dates and packaging) and place in tray once tray dry
3. Wash hands (see Figure 1)
4. Apply non-sterile gloves
5. Clamp central line and disconnect infusion device
6. Connect saline flush, unclamp central line and administer saline flush
7. Clamp central line and disconnect saline flush
8. Connect new infusion device, unclamp central line and infusion line (if applicable)
9. Re-cover line (if applicable)
10. Dispose of all equipment in yellow bag
11. Clean tray with Clinell wipe
12. Remove gloves
13. Wash hands
